DESCRIPTION

Corn gluten feed is a medium protein feed and is digested relatively rapidly. Its primary components are 45 percent neutral detergent fiber, 18 percent crude protein and 13 percent acid detergent fiber.¹ The feed is a byproduct of corn starch and corn syrup production. One bushel of corn yields 12.5 lbs of feed.²
